## OPERATING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

John Lansford conducted the meeting in the absence of Jim Rieske, Chairman.

The OCC Call Center report was given by Nicole Bradley, Tyler Nesheim and Kim Boyd (**see attached**). Doing Non-Compliance tickets on-line was discussed and approved.

John Lansford said MOCS has had complaints from excavators regarding underground facility owners using a robot system to clear tickets. The robot call isn't easily understood.

He discussed whether MOCS should allow public to do a ticket search – there were mixed opinions.

MOCS will have a new website by April 15.

Thirty-six breakfast safety meetings were held with good attendance.

April was proclaimed Dig Safely Month by the Governor.

The Missouri Public Service Commission has provided a legislative update (**see attached**), and has asked for comments by April 15. There are key elements being considered: enforcement, life of a ticket, sewer service laterals and presumption of negligence.

There is a courtesy backup phone call made to members for Emergency tickets. Often there is no answer and MOCS will need to decide how many attempts to make. This topic was held over.

There was discussion regarding providing an excavator email address. It was felt this would be a good feature.

The city limit question is still being researched.

The matter of allowing design requests size will be held over.

MOCS is continuing to obtain parcel data and will use Cole County as the test. Everyone felt a buffer should be added to the parcel both rural and city.

MOCS encourages members to use doorhangers when a locate is done. This would eliminate many of the phone calls MOCS staff receives regarding why the property was marked.
